Presented by the Administration upon B-101 1 2 recommendation of the Traffic Committee 3 4 5 CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO 6 - 2011 7 ORDINANCE NO. 8 THE 9 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TRAFFIC CONTROL FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION 10 OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND 11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 12 13 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established 14 and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and 15 maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified 16 17 Ordinances, and 18 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the 19 20 Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council, 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of 22 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that: 23 24 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic 25 26 Control File is hereby amended as follows: 27 To prohibit parking on the east side of Elmwood Street from Pierce 28 (1)Avenue north to the first intersecting driveway. 29 Remove "one hour only" between 7:00am - 6:00pm parking restriction 30 (2)31 on the north side of Highbridge Road between State Road and 20th 32 Street. 33 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in 34 35 the Traffic Control File the proper legends. 36 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the 37 installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments. 38 39 40 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances 41 42 and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and 43 44 confirmed. 45 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council 46 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an 47 open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of 48 any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open 49

of the Codified Ordinances. Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
