7		AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS	
8		DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A SECOND MODIFICATION OF	
9		CONTRACT NO. 7045 WITH CT CONSULTANTS, AND	

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Ord. No. 64-2014, the Director of Public Service entered into Contract No. 7045, with CT Consultants, for the professional design engineering services necessary to proceed with improvements to Howe Avenue from Main Street to Buchholzer Boulevard (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Section 181.06 of the Codified Ordinances, the City entered into a first modification of said contract on or about April 25, 2016; and

WHEREAS, for the Project to proceed, additional subsurface utility engineering, updating of the maintenance of traffic plans, and preparation of Phase I Environmental Site Assessment reports are required as directed by ODOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

 <u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into a second modification of Contract No. 7045, with CT Consultants, on the basis of its proposal dated October 21, 2016, in an amount not to exceed \$147,258.00. The total contract price after modification as authorized herein shall not exceed \$642,750.00.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 4.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote
