ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Prohibit parking on the even side of Charlene Drive, from Quick Road to Woodridge Drive.
- 2. Prohibit parking on the even side of Meadow Lane, from Quick Road to Charlene Drive.
- 3. Prohibit parking on the odd side of Center between the driveways at 515 Center.
- 4. Prohibit the use of any and all engine brakes within the City of Cuyahoga Falls except when used on public safety vehicles or for emergency purposes.

The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in the Traffic Control File the proper legends.

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
