Re: Rules Suspension

In your packet for Monday evening are Temp. Ords. B-20 and B-21, approving the payment of two moral claims.

In accordance with past practice, in order to permit the expeditious processing of the above claims, we are requesting that the rules be suspended to permit Council to consider and vote on these pieces of legislation on Monday evening.

Also in your packet is Temp. Ord. B-19 authorizing a modification of Contract No. 6609 that is for window replacement at the Municipal Building. Because of the long lead time associated with custom manufacture of windows for the municipal building, and the possibility of increased costs associated with delay, we are requesting that Council suspend its rules in order to consider and vote on this ordinance on Monday evening.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH INNOPRISE SOFTWARE, INC., FOR THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES NECESSARY TO INSTALL, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE AN ENTERPRISE SOFTWARE SYSTEM, INCLUDING ASSOCIATED SOFTWARE LICENSING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contact or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Innoprise, Software, Inc., on the basis of its proposal dated February 24, 2011, for the professional services necessary to install, maintain and operate a full enterprise software system, including implementation, data conversion, training, upgrades, modifications, and technical support, as well as software licensing.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for lump sum implementation and software licensing fees from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay, and for maintenance fees from funds properly appropriated therefor.

<u>Section 3</u>. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 4</u>.
