14 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Police Department, and the law enforcement agencies of various
15 political subdivisions within Summit County ("Participants") have determined that they can make a more
16 efficient use of their powers and resources by providing a higher quality of law enforcement services to the
17 public through the coordination of existing governmental units to other jurisdictions; and
18

19 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls and Participants each may own and maintain a Mobile Field
20 Force ("MFF") unit, but may provide their MFF units and staff for operational assistance across
21 jurisdictional lines within Summit County, Ohio; and
22

23 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the Participants have the authority under the Ohio Revised
24 Code Sections 505.43, 737.04 and 3345.041 to enter into this operational assistance agreement for law
25 enforcement cooperation and assistance that crosses jurisdictional lines within Summit County, Ohio.
26

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
28 Ohio:
29

30 Section 1. That the Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, is hereby authorized to enter into a Mobile Field
31 Force Multi-Jurisdiction Operational Assistance Mutual Aid Agreement with various political subdivisions
32 within Summit County, Ohio.
33

34 Section 2. That any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
35 herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
36 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
37

38 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
39 the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations
40 of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to
41 the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
42

43 Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
44 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and
45 the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or
46 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the
47 Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
