New Ordinances & Resolutions

Temp. Ord. A-80

An ordinance authorizing and approving a conditional zoning certificate to operate an outdoor sales lot on Parcel 35-00079 (4095 State Road), in an MU3 Sub-Urban Center District, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. A-81

An ordinance approving a zoning map amendment for Parcel 02-00234 (2404 7th Street) from R4 Urban Density Residential to MU4 Sub-Urban Corridor, as more fully described and depicted herein and declaring an emergency.
